COPENHAGEN

HOW TO GET TO THE DANISH TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE

1) If you come from Copenhagen Airport

DTI is 27 km from Copenhagen Airport. The Airport is well-connected, offering several options: metro, train, and bus, all departing from Terminal 3. If you arrive at Terminal 2, take the free shuttle to Terminal 3. The shuttle runs every 15-20 minutes and takes just over 5 minutes.

Metro

Metro line 2 (yellow) connects Terminal 3 directly to the city centre in about 15 minutes, depending on your stop. From metro line 2 change to metro line 3 (red) or metro line 4 (blue) to go to Copenhagen Central Station København H. It operates 24/7 with high frequency: every 4-6 minutes during the day and 15-20 minutes at night. A single ticket for 3 zones costs 36 DKK (4.8 euros approx.), available at station ticket offices, and vending machines.

Regional Trains

Regional trains (S-tog) link the airport's train station at Terminal 3 to Copenhagen Central Station København H in about 13-15 minutes. Direct. Trains run approximately every 10-15 minutes. The fare is the same as the metro, 36 DKK (4.8 euros approx.) for a single 3-zone ticket, available at station ticket offices, and vending machines.

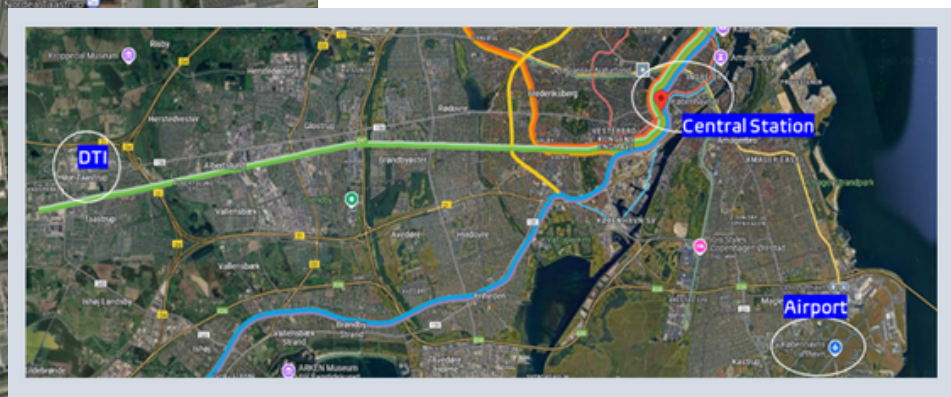
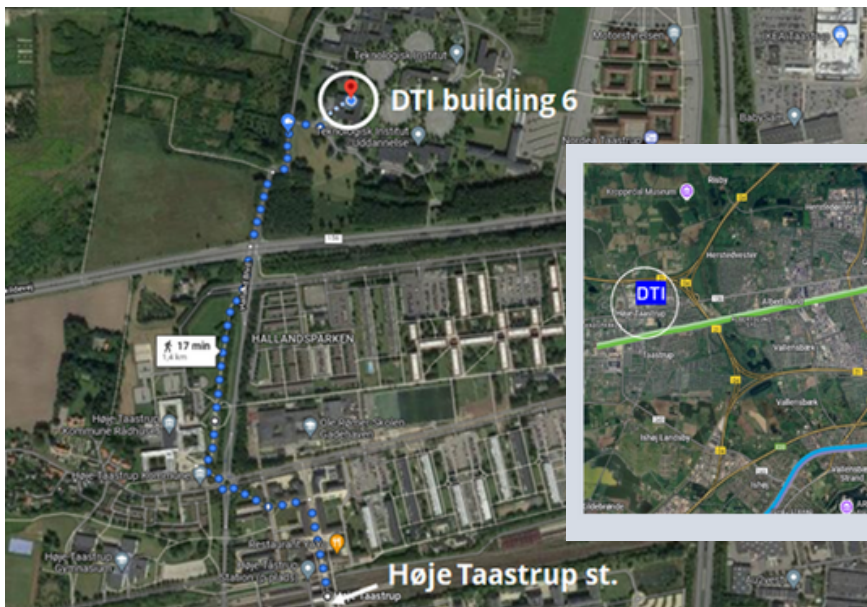
Taxi

From the Airport is about 600-745 DKK (80-100 euros), depending on traffic.

2) If you come from Copenhagen city center

DTI is 25 km from Copenhagen city centre. Take any train to Copenhagen Central Station København H. From the central station, take S-Tog Line B toward Høje Taastrup Station (departure every 12 minutes, 25 minutes journey).

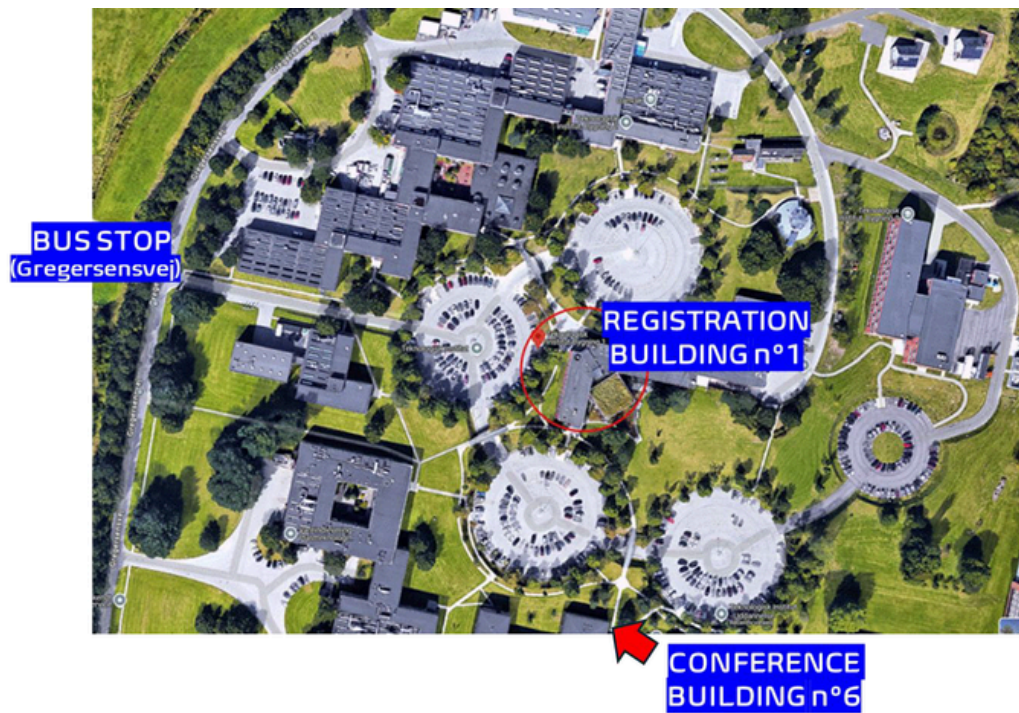
The walk from Høje Taastrup St. to DTI is less than 20 min, or 5 min by bus (bus 400S).



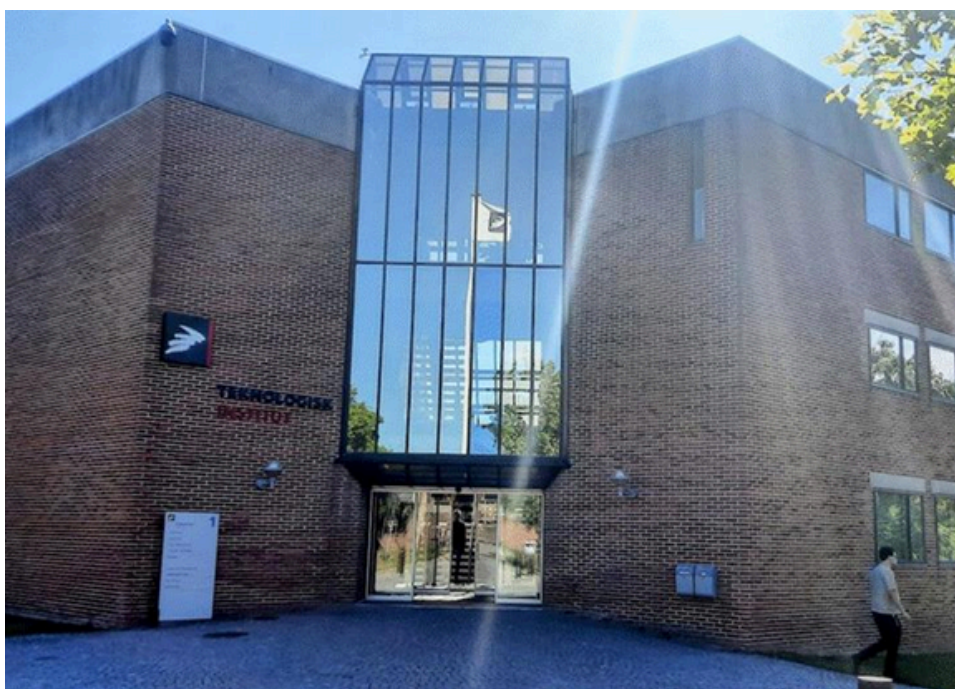


ONCE YOU ARRIVE... HOW TO REGISTER AT THE DANISH TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE

You need to register at the reception of the DTI once you arrive (Building N°1). The DTI team will guide you to the registration and conference buildings.

HOTEL SUGGESTIONS

We suggest finding a hotel in Copenhagen close to the central station, as it will be well connected for reaching DTI.

SCANDIC COPENHAGUE. VESTER SØGADE 6, 1602 KØBENHAVN

Very good 8.2/10, Good location, just a ten-minute walk from Tivoli Gardens and City Hall Square.

BEST WESTERN HOTEL HEBRON. HELGOLANDSGADE 4, 1653 KØBENHAVN

Very good 8.4/10. Just a 5-minute walk from Tivoli Gardens and Copenhagen Central Station.

TIVOLI HOTEL. ARNI MAGNUSSONS GADE 2, 1577 KØBENHAVN

Very good 8.4/10. Next to the Copenhagen canal and a 10-minute walk from Copenhagen Central Station.

COPENHAGEN ISLAND. KALVEBOD BRYGGE 53, 1560 KØBENHAVN

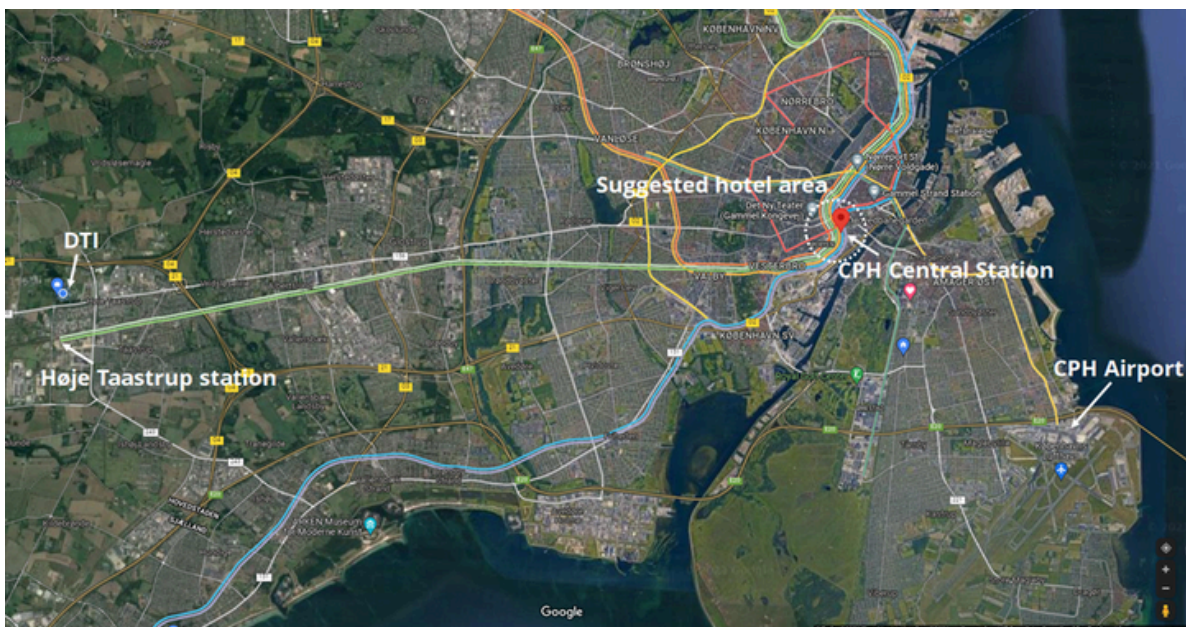
Very good 8.6/10. Located on an artificial island in the centre of Copenhagen, right next to the Fisketorvet shopping centre. Dybbølsbro train station is a 5-minute walk away.

WAKEUP COPENHAGEN, CARSTEN NIEBUHRS GADE. CARSTEN NIEBUHRS GADE 11, 1577 KØBENHAVN

Very good 7.8/10. Centre of Copenhagen, just a 15-minute walk from the Tivoli Gardens amusement park. It is about 850 metres from Dybbølsbro train station

CABINN COPENHAGEN. ARNI MAGNUSSONS GADE 1, 1577 KØBENHAVN

Good 6.9/10. Eco-friendly hotel located 1.2 km from Copenhagen Central Station and Tivoli Gardens.
